- b. Creation of Section 9.28.060 to prohibit the carrying of firearms and weapons in city buildings.

Attorney Merten stated this ordinance is basically the same as Resolution #8406-11 (prohibits the carrying of firearms and weapons in buildings, owned, or control by the City, and at special events on City of Brookfield property passed Nov. 1, 2011). The proposed ordinance can now be codified and police can take enforcement. Alderman Mahkorn stated this is consistent with the resolution from 2011. He supports it.

**Motion by Alderman Carnell, second by Alderman McCarthy to approve the creation of Section 9.28.060 to prohibit the carrying of firearms and weapons in city buildings. Motion carried 4-0.**
