HIDDEN LAKE NEIGHBORHOOD PARK AND TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS PUBLIC OPEN FORUM AND PLAN REVIEW

The Brookfield Parks and Recreation Commission has recommended that funding be included in the 2017 Capital Improvement Budget and has initiated a planning and public review/input process to implement improvements at the recently acquired 14+/- acre Hidden Lake park site adjacent to Lilly Road and south of Waynescott Road in Section 13 of the City. The preliminary concept development plan includes a small parking lot; a trail connecting the public walkway on Lilly Road into the park with a continuing trail through the park to access a small scenic viewing deck at the shoreline of the adjacent quarry lake; play equipment; a small open air shelter; and a playfield (open space). In addition, preliminary plans have been developed to construct an off road trail that would extend to the south and east from the trail in the park, through the adjacent private conservancy area around the south of the lake, and connect to 131st and Center Streets as part of the ongoing implementation of the Greenway Trail System.

Interested residents will have an opportunity to review and provide comment regarding the preliminary park and trail development plans over the next few months. There will be a Public Open Forum and Plan Review held on Thursday, September 14th in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall (2000 N. Calhoun Road). The forum will be conducted in an open house format and interested individuals are welcome to attend anytime between the hours of 5:00-7:00 p.m. The preliminary park plan, trail segment/system plans, background information, and other related exhibits will be displayed and there will be an opportunity to ask questions, exchange information and offer suggestions regarding the projects with City staff and consultants.

In addition, the Commission will receive public comment pertaining to the park and trail development plans as part of their regular meeting on Monday, November 13th, 7:00 p.m. in the Senior Community Center of Brookfield City Hall, 2000 N. Calhoun Road.
