Plan components are subject to change based at any time. This includes restricting or expanding guidelines for the safety of facility users. Our guidelines do not replace or supersede any protocols or restrictions outlined by state or local authorities.

HEALTH GUIDELINES

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention offers recommendations on how members of the public can limit the spread of the coronavirus.

- Anyone sick or show symptoms of being sick should stay home.
- Stay at least 6 feet away from non-household members.
- Cover your mouth and nose with tissue when coughing or sneezing.
- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Wear a cloth face covering that covers your nose and mouth in public settings.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and game equipment

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Staff will sanitize any indoor spaces before usage each day.
- Maximums in all programs have been reduced to ensure adequate social distancing.
- Instructors will remind participants to keep physical distancing from other program participants.
- Participants will bring their own water bottles.
- Masks will not be required while participating in programming, however, spectators/parents are encouraged, not required, to wear a mask when not participating in the activity and social distancing is not possible.
- Participants will bring their own personal equipment as needed. No shared equipment will be used.
- Participants are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer – all parks and recreation instructors are provided with disinfecting wipes and hand sanitizer to use as needed.
- Outdoor programming is not permitted to utilize indoor restrooms or other spaces.
- Brookfield Parks, Recreation & Forestry will provide a portable toilet on site where outdoor programming takes place for participant and staff usage.
- If a program participant notifies the City of Brookfield Parks and Recreation Department that they have tested positive for COVID-19, other participants in that activity will be notified by the Department.
