How The Memorial Tree Program Works:

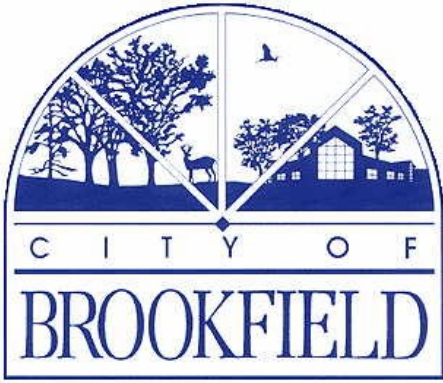
The City of Brookfield Department of Parks, Recreation, and Forestry assist donors and supervises the selection, purchase, placement, and maintenance of trees suitable for planting in Brookfield's public Parks and landscaped areas.

All contributions are acceptable and accumulate toward the price of a tree. Cost of individual trees range from \$200 to \$400 depending on type and size of tree.

Names of those honored and the names of the donors are inscribed in a leather bound Memorial Tree Registry located in the office of the Mayor in City Hall.

Recognition by card will be sent to all donors and families of those being honored. A small tag with the name of the honored will be placed in the tree.
